




3 DAYS SOSSUSVLEI SAFARI SHUTTLE

Exciting adventures await those who partake in this exhilarating safari! A three-day excursion, with accommodation included, offers a stress-free experience at Sossusvlei and the Namib Desert, one of the most spectacular sites in the world. En-route to this ancient desert, visitor's journey down breath-taking slopes as the Spreetshoogte Pass unfurls to the Namib Desert floor. Unexpected canyons and vleis, and unique local settlements add awe-inspiring scenery and diversity to the trip. The magnificent star dunes of the Namib are a photographer's dream, and the spectacular landscape will leave memories to last a lifetime.

3 DAYS ITINERARY

Day 1: Windhoek – Namib Desert

Guests are collected from their lodgings in Windhoek at approximately 14:00. The journey to the Namib Naukluft Park begins via the scenic Spreetshoogte Pass – one of Namibia’s steepest and most Scenic Mountain passes. A quick stopover at the small settlement of Solitaire caters for refreshments and some sweet delights. The night is spent at the Namib Desert Lodge, based at the foot of ancient, fossilised dunes or The Desert Grace. While enveloped in this oasis, it almost seems as though time stands still.

Day 2: Sossusvlei

An early start to the day awaits. Much of the day is spent climbing the highest sand dunes in the world. Big Daddy offers a strenuous climb, but the view along the crest is completely worth it. Upon descent, the whispering sands of the Namib lead to the ancient camelthorn trees of Dead Vlei – one of the most photographed areas in Sossusvlei. Exploration continues into the rugged Sesriem Canyon before returning to the lodge for the evening, but the day is not yet done. The second night of the safari is concluded with a sunset dune drive where the crimson horizon can be appreciated from the crest of the fossilised dunes in the Gondwana Namib Park.

Day 3: Namib Desert Lodge / [The Desert Grace](#) – Windhoek

Rise and shine, as the capital awaits! After breakfast, the shuttle returns to Windhoek via the Remhoogte Pass – although this pass is not as steep as the Spreetshoogte, it offers beautiful scenery. Expect to arrive in the city at around 12:30, although please note that times may vary.

Booking and Confirmation Terms:

All bookings must be communicated in writing. 60 days before the departure of the tour, we would ask for reconfirmation of the booking.

Payment Terms:

Tour operators without credit facilities:

Payment strictly 30 days before guest arrival / or per your payment agreement & terms.

Last-minute bookings made within the 30-day-period require immediate payment within 48 hours of the time of booking.

Cancellation Policy Terms:

All cancellations must be communicated in writing.

Gondwana Collection Namibia reserves the right to impose the following cancellation fees:

29 - 60 days:	10%
22 - 28 days:	20%
15 - 21 days:	30%
08 - 14 days:	50%
04 - 07 days:	75%
01 - 03 days:	90%

Our amended cancellation terms related to COVID-19, valid until the end of our 2022 season (31.10.2022):

0% cancellation fee until 7 days before arrival date.

This would only be related to the following scenario:

Should a client not be able to arrive in Namibia due to COVID-19 related instances (e.g., being suspected of carrying the Coronavirus and not being allowed to board the plane to Namibia, border closures, either in Namibia or abroad, inclusive of neighbouring borders if it is a cross border itinerary, quarantine advice, fresh lockdown, or the like) and where this inability to travel is beyond the control of the guest. These amended cancellation fees are related to COVID-19, not for all causes.

We strongly suggest that all clients take out comprehensive travel insurance.

It is the responsibility of clients to ensure that passports, visas, or other travel documents are valid for the duration of their stay in Namibia and other places included in their itinerary.
